 - Nominations: February 21st – March 21st Members interested in running for office must notify the Guild of their intent in writing via fax (323) 851-8572, Courier, Email, or US Mail no later than 4:00 p.m. March 21st.
 - Deadline of March 23rd to complete and sign official membership card to be eligible run for a position.
 - Deadline of April 6th to complete & sign official membership card to be eligible to vote.
 - Onsite election – Wednesday, May 2nd.
 - Announcement of election results – Wednesday, May 9th.
 - Certification of election results and the swearing of the newly elected Executive Board at the June meeting.
